not contain any educational content. They find that the educational show largely worked. Young viewers who were exposed to MTV Shuga were less likely to have concurrent sexual partners. They were also twice as likely to get tested for HIV eight months after watching the show compared to those who watched the non-educational show. They also find that reductions in sexually transmitted diseases, such as chlamydia, among women. All these effects were the strongest among the viewers who reported being the most involved in the show's narrative

However, the authors did not find any significant change in attitude towards condom use, despite that being a prominent message in MTV Shuga. One possible explanation could be the strong cultural resistance to condoms in the Nigerian context, which the show failed to overcome. Despite this, the authors argue that the overriding message of the results are that people react to the messages they see on TV. This could have important implications for the use of 'edutainment' methods by policymakers.


