Overview

The Egypt Impact Lab (EIL), in collaboration with the Universal Health Insurance Authority (UHIA) and the World Health Organization (WHO) in Egypt, is hosting the third session of the *Knowledge Exchange Webinar Series – Bridging Health Systems*. This session will explore **Informal Workers' Inclusion in Health Coverage**, drawing on Indonesia's experience to inform the rollout of Egypt's Universal Health Insurance System (UHIS).

The series—organized by EIL, UHIA, and WHO—promotes government-to-government learning and practical policy dialogue on advancing Universal Health Coverage. This third session will feature experts and policymakers from Indonesia and Egypt to:

- Share country experiences on enrolling informal workers in national health insurance systems.
- Discuss policy, operational, and behavioral barriers to informal worker enrollment and strategies to overcome them.
- Reflect on how international evidence can be adapted to Egypt's context to strengthen the
 inclusiveness and financial sustainability of UHIS.

The session will bring together policymakers, health economists, and development partners to advance a shared understanding of how Egypt can effectively expand UHIS coverage to include informal workers.
