J-PAL's Jobs and Opportunity Initiative (JOI) funds randomized evaluations that address pressing labor market challenges related to supply and matching, job creation, and the future of jobs. JOI is now calling for proposals from J-PAL affiliates, J-PAL postdocs, and JOI invited researchers for full research projects, pilot studies, travel/proposal development grants, and policy outreach support grants. PhD students, with support from an advisor who is a J-PAL affiliate or JOI invited researcher, are also eligible to apply. Resident African scholars are also eligible to apply for pilot studies and travel/proposal development grants. **Letters of interest are due by Tuesday, March 15, 2022 at 1:00 PM US ET. Proposals are due by Tuesday, April 26, 2022 at 1:00 PM US ET.**
