Increasing workplace productivity through financial stability in India

Financial stress and worries associated with poverty can directly affect people's ability to work effectively and increase their incomes. In a randomized evaluation in India, J-PAL affiliated professors [Supreet Kaur](#) (UC Berkeley), [Sendhil Mullainathan](#) (University of Chicago), and [Frank Schilbach](#) (MIT), with Suanna Oh, found that giving small-scale manufacturing workers early wage payments for greater financial stability increased productivity and attention to detail among workers with higher preexisting financial strain.
